District allocated surplus monies now, \$43,000.00 to KES. Staff meeting will be held to discuss where to spend this money. Reading support seems to be a much needed area, This will be finalized soon and Cathy McCubbin will have an update at our next PAC meeting.

In Sechelt the SD is looking to set up a youth Drop in Centre, next to the strong start and tiny town. SD has applied for grant money to do renovations and update the spaces.

Happy to see that the school field was in fact not a big lake at this time of year. The field was hydro seeded three weeks ago.

There is an opportunity for input on the School Districts budget every year. Really looking into an apprenticeship program at the secondary level, as well as special needs funding, fine Arts and Libraries. The last two programs have been consistently cut over the last ten years, and we would really like to see them coming back.
